If you have a registration authorization for the 2021-2022 academic year, in a higher education institution, you have the possibility to apply for accommodation in a university residence at the CROUS LILLE NORD PAS-DE-CALAIS.

Your application for admission to a university residence must be submitted electronically only. You must realize the two operations below :

1/ Create an account on

2/ After logging in on [messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr](https://www.messervices.etudiant.gouv.fr), you can submit your housing request by clicking on « Trouver un logement en résidence CROUS » section, from July 9 2021, depending on the availability that will be displayed. Please note, the number of housing is very limited and you will not necessarily get a housing.

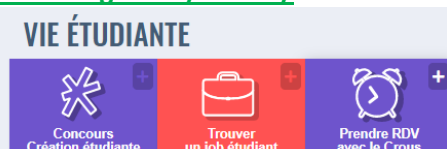

Priority will be given:

- To scholarship holders from the french government BGF, from foreign governments BGE under agreements signed with the CNOUS and Campus France
- Students under a European mobility programme and inter-university exchanges under agreements between CROUS and higher education institutions.
- Students enrolled in higher education levels at Bac + 3

LIVELIHOOD

You are reminded that you must be able to meet your living expenses, either by scholarship or by sufficient personal resources (as a guide, you must have at least 615 euros per month to meet your daily needs).

Also, make sure that the regulations in force allow transfers of funds from your country to France.

Please note: Given the current employment situation in the North as well as in the Pas-de-Calais, students may find it very difficult to find even temporary employment.
