LANGUAGE OF INSTRUCTION

All our Bachelor's degree programs are taught in French.

Only a selected number of courses is offered in English at the Master level:

- Master International Trade & B2B Marketing

A B1 level in French is recommended but we do not require evidence of this level.

French compulsory classes (3 ECTS/semester), exempted for students whose mother tongue is French. Possibility to attend conversational workshop in the Boulogne-sur-Mer campus for 2 additional ECTS.
